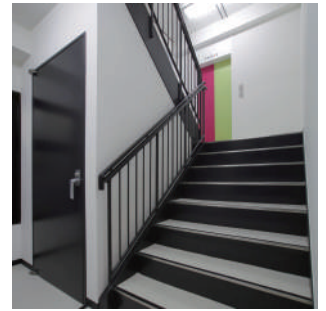

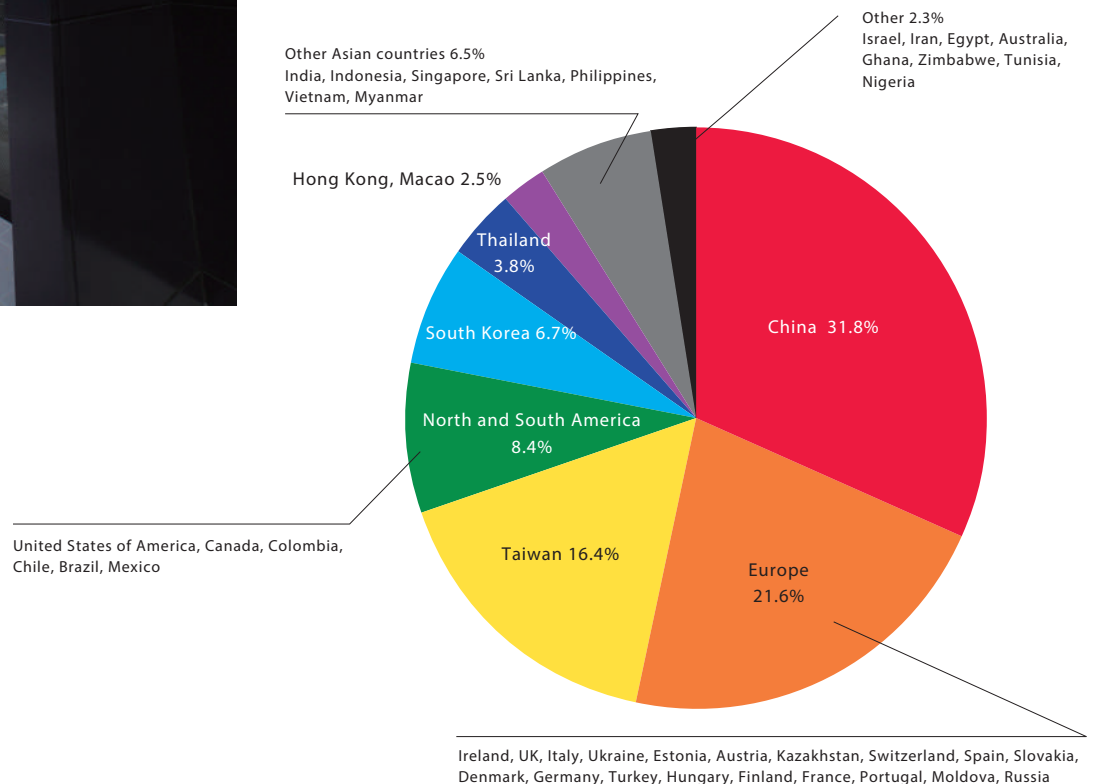
Main Building

Second Building

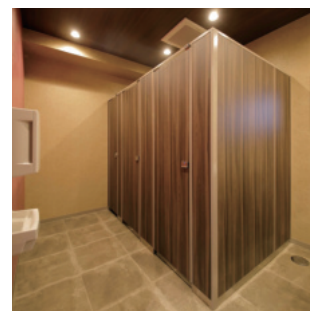

We value an environment where students can study before or after classes, or just relax and chat with friends.



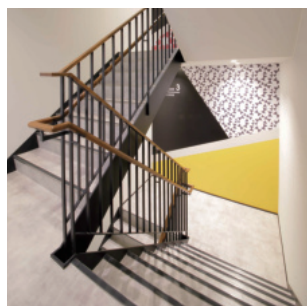

It is also possible to study Japanese for three months using long holidays from work or school. There are many things you can learn even in a limited period of three months, such as short-term study with a focus on future studies in Japan, brushing up your Japanese before exams, improving your Japanese communication skills and experiencing Japanese culture.



You can attend classes online without having to come to Japan, and make use of your spare time between work or household duties. We offer both group lessons and private lessons to suit your needs.

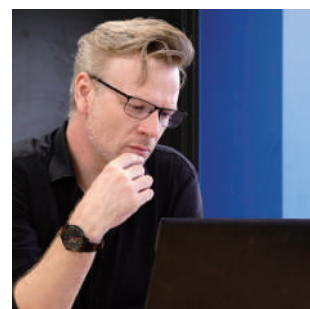

Orientation Book

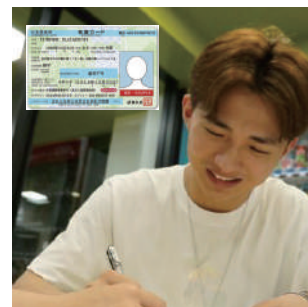

After arriving in Japan, we will hold a new student orientation, which contains a lot of important information, so please read through it carefully before your arrival.

Support for Official Procedures

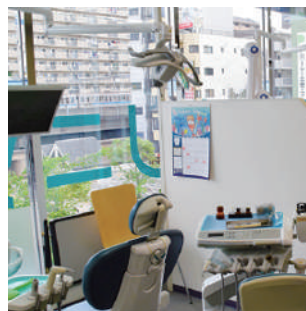

School alliance clinic "Keiseikai clinic" provides thorough health support for each student. The clinic offers internal medicine and dental services. TLS students (long-term courses only) are exempt from the consultation fee. Feel free to use it as your regular clinic and a place to consult about your health.

If you visit for a procedure not covered by insurance (esthetic related), you will be charged at actual cost.

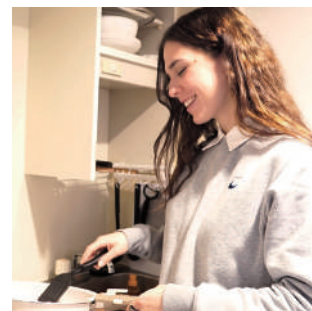

TLS has 5 dormitories, providing a comfortable living environment for international students to concentrate on their studies. All dormitories are located within 15 minutes by bicycle, making it easy to commute to school. 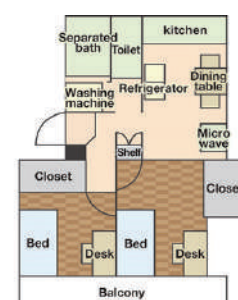


Roomie Sakongawa

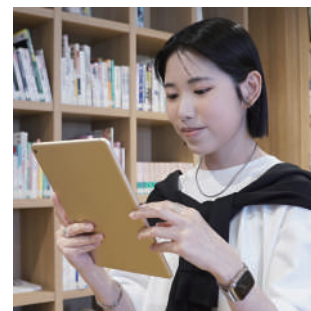

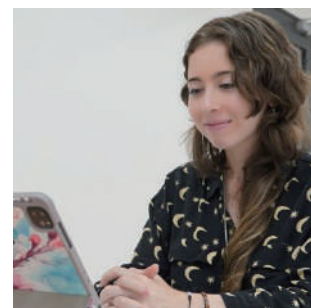

Flow of the day

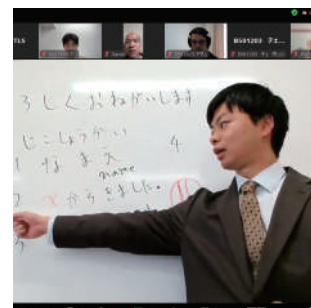
1. Greetings and explanations
